Dear Mayor Mrakas,

On behalf of the Mavericks Water Polo Club, I'd like to express excitement and support for the development of a new competition pool in Aurora. As an aquatics sport organization in Ontario, fresh water is welcome news!

Water polo is a fast, fun fitness-oriented sport that can easily grow to be an anchor tenant in the right facility. As an idea of the kind of activity a water polo club can support, in going from start-up to ~ 50 members, a club would likely need 10-15 hours of pool time across 4-6 days per week. Obviously, as membership rises, pool time needs increase.

Over the past decade, following a strategic shift in our operation, The Mavericks have grown from a club of about 60 to one that reached more 200 members prior to Covid-19 closures. We serve an active membership of girls, boys, men and women... ages 7-40 with most of our players falling in the 10-20 age group.

I believe the development strategy that has seen The Mavericks grow to the #1 club in Canada (2019) is one that can be successfully adopted by other groups. I would be happy to offer counsel to the board of a new club in the area and to share some of the tactics that have worked well for us. And would reach out to our network to help find a local champion interested in building a club in Aurora.
